But how...


- Your first job does not matter!

 - Career Fair




Recruitment and Interviewing Tips

Recruitment and Interviewing Tips

What companies want to test you on:

- Analytical skills Quick & scrappy analysis
- Problem solving Case studies
- Behavioral past experience to demonstrate you are a team player, and have a good track record of success
- Leadership influence your peers without authority

In general, for interviews...

- You can get things done quickly while maintain high quality of work
- Eager to learn and able to teach others
- Not shy away from taking ownership, "that's not my job"
